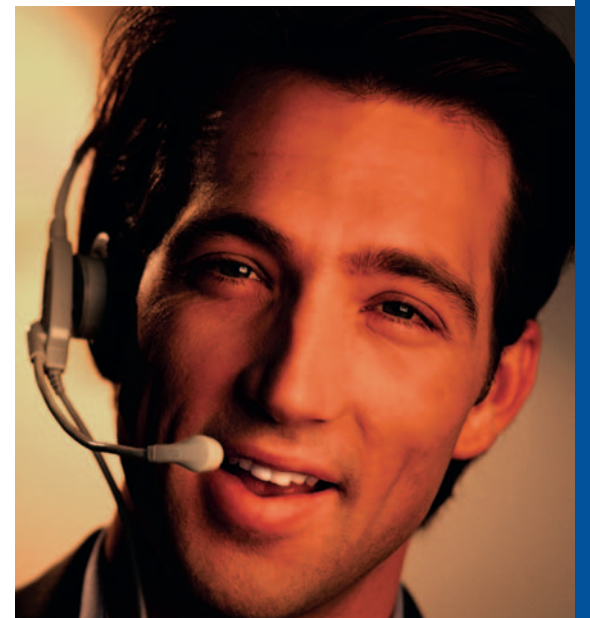


## Job Training
