Get started with the six-step WIRED blueprint for regional success

- **Identify the Regional Economy:** identify surrounding areas that share the same economic structure
- **Form Core Leadership Group:** form a core leadership group representing the major assets of the region
- **SWOT Analysis:** conduct an analysis of regional strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats
- **Regional Identity and Vision:** develop a regional identity and vision for economic growth
- **Devise Strategies:** develop strategies that are specific, measurable, achievable, realistic, and timely
- **Leverage Resources and Implement:** leverage resources from private, non-profit, and government sources in support of the common goals
